Each month some truly wonderful armory designs from kingdoms all over the Known World are registered by the Society's College of Arms. All accepted (and returned) heraldic submissions are listed on that month's Laurel Letter of Acceptances and Returns, which can be found at <http://heraldry.sca.org/loar/>. The very best submitted items get a "Nice name!" or "Nice device!" or "Nice badge!" comment upon registration, meaning they are as period and authentic as possible. It may surprise many people to find out that nice simple period-style armory hasn't all been taken, and is still quite possible to register!

This is but a small selection of the very nice devices and badges registered in April 2012, when the new standards took effect:

Sophie Federspil (Ansteorra). Device: *Per fess gules and Or, two bees counterchanged.*

Richard of Wyvern Cliff (Calontir). Device: *Or, a dragon gules and on a chief embattled azure three crosses formy Or.*

Fionn mac Con Dhuibh (East). Device: *Azure, three orbs argent.*

Michael de Quarmby (Middle). Device: *Paly dancetty vert and argent.*

Titus Marius Caninus (Middle). Device: *Paly gules and argent, three greyhounds statant sable collared argent.*
