Each month some truly wonderful armory designs from kingdoms all over the Known World are registered by the Society's College of Arms. All accepted (and returned) heraldic submissions are listed on that month's Laurel Letter of Acceptances and Returns, which can be found at <http://heraldry.sca.org/loar/>. The very best submitted items get a "Nice name!" or "Nice device!" or "Nice badge!" comment upon registration, meaning they are as period and authentic as possible. It may surprise many people to find out that nice simple period-style armory hasn't all been taken, and is still quite possible to register!

This is but a small selection of the very nice devices and badges registered in May 2012:

Gerard de Rueil (Æthelmarc). Device: *Argent, two lions combatant gules, a chief counter-ermine.*

Gilbert de Walghop (Lochac). Device: *Quarterly gules and sable, a pair of compasses Or.*

Mathias von Massenbach (Lochac). Device: *Checky sable and argent, a bear rampant Or.*

Orbei Qorchi (Lochac). Device: *Or, a chevron inverted vert.*

Beatrisia Mercier (Middle). Device: *Argent, a chevron pean between three lozenges azure.*
