The very best submitted items get a "Nice name!" or "Nice device!" or "Nice badge!" comment upon registration, meaning they are as period and authentic as possible. It may surprise many people to find out that nice simple period-style armory hasn't all been taken, and is still quite possible to register!

This is but a small selection of the very nice devices and badges registered in June 2012:

Keyna Morgan Oulton (Ansteora). Badge: *(Fieldless) An eagle per pale Or and purpure.*

Josep Müllich (Atenveldt). Badge: *Per bend vert and argent, a cross formy counterchanged.*

Ghita da Solari (East). Device: *Per pale gules and Or, two sea-horses respectant counterchanged.*

Rosamund Laiborn (Lochac). Device: *Azure, on a bend between two roses Or three martlets sable.*

Hrefna Cyrredes dohtor (Outlands). Device: *Quarterly sable and argent, a heart counterchanged.*
