All accepted (and returned) heraldic submissions are listed on that month's Laurel Letter of Acceptances and Returns, which can be found at <http://heraldry.sca.org/loar/>. The very best submitted items get a "Nice name!" or "Nice device!" or "Nice badge!" comment upon registration, meaning they are as period and authentic as possible. It may surprise many people to find out that nice simple period-style armory hasn't all been taken, and is still quite possible to register!

This is but a small selection of the very nice devices and badges registered in July 2012:

Anne of Brackley (Atenveldt). Device: *Per bend argent and purpure, a maunche counterchanged.*

Willow of Cairn Fell (Lochac). Device: *Checky vert and argent, a horse rampant sable.*

Andrew von Otelingen (Outlands). Badge: *(Fieldless) A barrel azure hooped argent.*

Elizabeth Anne Grene (Outlands). Device: *Per pale purpure and vert, a bordure argent.*

Maria Clara de Madrid (West). Device: *Sable, a Latin cross flory and in chief three cinquefoils Or.*
