All accepted (and returned) heraldic submissions are listed on that month's Laurel Letter of Acceptances and Returns, which can be found at <http://heraldry.sca.org/loar/>. The very best submitted items get a "Nice name!" or "Nice device!" or "Nice badge!" comment upon registration, meaning they are as period and authentic as possible. It may surprise many people to find out that nice simple period-style armory hasn't all been taken, and is still quite possible to register!

This is but a small selection of the very nice devices and badges registered in August 2012:

Dafyd ap Tomas (Caid). Device: *Quarterly gules and vert, a sheaf of arrows argent.*

Arnþóra of Wemyss (Meridies). Badge: *(Fieldless) A fer-a-loup gules.*

Ardien Dochesefford (Trimaris). Device: *Bendy sinister gules and argent, a bordure sable.*

Arianwen ferch Morgan (West). Device: *Per pale azure and argent all semy of roses counterchanged.*
