Morwenna de Bonnay (Lochac). Device: Purpure, three owls Or.

Cyriac Gray of Heaton (Meridies). Device: Argent, on a bend engrailed sable three stag's heads erased argent.

Froði Ketilsson (Middle). Device: Sable, in pale three musical bows fesswise argent.
