All accepted (and returned) heraldic submissions are listed on that month's Laurel Letter of Acceptances and Returns, which can be found at <http://heraldry.sca.org/loar/>. The very best submitted items get a "Nice name!" or "Nice device!" or "Nice badge!" comment upon registration, meaning they are as period and authentic as possible. It may surprise many people to find out that nice simple period-style armory hasn't all been taken, and is still quite possible to register!

This is but a small selection of the very nice devices and badges registered in October 2012:

Takeda Sanjuichiro Akimasa (Æthelmarc). Badge: *Per pale azure and argent, a chief sable.*

Hugh MacDonald of Belfast (Caid). Device: *Vert, a chevron doubly cotised argent.*

Stæina Hálfanardóttir (Caid). Device: *Per pale gules and argent, three thistles counterchanged.*

Duncan de Montdragon (East). Badge: *Per pale Or and gules, two bears combattant counterchanged.*

Rowland of Lincolnshire (Outlands). Badge: *Per pale argent and sable, a mullet within a bordure counterchanged.*
