All accepted (and returned) heraldic submissions are listed on that month's Laurel Letter of Acceptances and Returns, which can be found at <http://heraldry.sca.org/loar/>. The very best submitted items get a "Nice name!" or "Nice device!" or "Nice badge!" comment upon registration, meaning they are as period and authentic as possible. It may surprise many people to find out that nice simple period-style armory hasn't all been taken, and is still quite possible to register!

This is but a small selection of the very nice devices and badges registered in November 2012:

Dietrich Wyß (Ansteorra). Device: *Per pale sable and argent, a vol counterchanged.*

Artus Peryere (Atlantia). Device: *Sable, on a chevron between three wolf's heads erased Or three hearts gules.*

Constanza of Thamesreach (Drachenwald). Device: *Erminois, a dance gules.*

Karl Faustus von Aachen (Lochac). Device: *Per pale gules and azure, a bordure Or.*

Gryfyn de Moyon (Trimaris). Device: *Per pale gules and sable, six crescents three, two, and one Or.*
